## 5 ELEMENTS TO BIBLICAL MINISTRY

- The **P** stands for **PLANTING** Churches
- The **E** stands for **EQUIPPING** Leaders
- The **A** stands for **ASSIST** the Poor
- The **C** stands for **CARING** for the Sick
- The **E** stands for **EDUCATION**

## 1. **P** PLANTING Churches

Jesus of was the very first to plant a church.

*“And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.”*

**Matthew 16:18** (NIV)

*1* When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. *2* Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. *3* They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. *4* All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them. **Acts 2:1-4** (NIV)

## 2. **E** \_\_\_\_\_ Servant Leaders

*“For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”* **Mark 10:45** (NIV)

- Servant leadership starts with an \_\_\_\_\_.
- Starts with an attitude but it ends with action.

*14* “Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another’s feet. *15* I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you. *16* Very truly I tell you, no servant is greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him.” **John 13:14-16** (NIV)

3. **A** \_\_\_\_\_ the Poor

*“The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he’s anointed me to preach Good News to the poor.” Luke 4:18 (NIV)*

- Does God have favourites? Yes he does.
- He loves the poor and the oppressed.

4. **C** \_\_\_\_\_ for the Sick

*Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and **sickness** among the people. Matthew 9:35 (NIV)*

5. **E** \_\_\_\_\_

- Jesus educated the next generation.

***15** People were also bringing babies to Jesus for him to place his hands on them. When the disciples saw this, they rebuked them. **16** But Jesus called the children to him and said, “Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. Luke 18:15-16 (NIV)*
