Q: Why is it that so many of us struggle to truly experience God's love in our hearts?

1. REJECTION ISSUES

Rejection has to do with the People in our lives who have not accepted us, not welcomed us, not invited us, not approved of us, maybe even made fun of us and ask us to leave.

2. PERFECTION ISSUES

Doing things right, being the best, doing the best, no room for error, no margin for fault or failure. If you were raised in an environment or live in an environment like that then your best was never good enough.

3. ABANDONMENT ISSUES

Abandonment has to do with the people in your life whom you by nature dependent upon to provide you with the basic needs of love, affection, support, protection, provision, and security, who end up leaving you, either physically or emotionally.

4. FEAR ISSUES

We are talking about abnormal, inordinate and excessive fears.

There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love. 1 JOHN 4:18 NIV

5. INSECURITY ISSUES

Insecurity can result from simply having been constantly judged, criticized, or condemned.

17...I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, 18 may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, 19 and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.
